Materials Needed:


White Gesso Black glossy acrylic paint Pigma Pens (black) Pink or Reddish acrylic paint Colored Pencils – gray, brown, red


Important!

- ALWAYS paint on STUFFED dolls. Remember to make several dolls so you can practice on one.
- These faces are designed to be painted on various shades of brown cotton fabric to create ethnic dolls.

Directions:

- Paint white gesso for eyes. Draw a shape on top of dried Gesso for top of eyes with black Pigma pen.
- Add black eyes with acrylic paint and eyelids with black Pigma pen.
- Add eyebrows and eyelashes with Pigma pen. Add white highlight to eye with Gesso.
- Draw nose and shadow with gray colored pencil. Be sure and add shadows above eyelids as well as inside corners of eyes. Make nostrils darker using black Pigma pen.
- Make center mouth line using black Pigma pen.
- Fill in lips with colored pencil (dark on top, lighter on bottom) and shadows at the mouth.
- 7. Paint the hairline LAST and then the back of the head with a heavy application of glossy black acrylic paint. This can be messy. Let front dry before painting back of head. Be careful not to get any paint on rest of the doll!


BOYS PANTS


1.Cut fabric 13" X 10". Fold in half wrong side together and stitch the long side. Turn right side out. Stitch short ends together and press open.


 Place the center back seam against the center front and stitch a U shape to form the trouser legs, cut U out leaving 1/4" seem. Clip and turn right side out. Gather waist to fit or use tucks or small elastic.

NECK SCARF

Cut fabric 2"X 12". Fold in 1/3 sections and press, knot around the neck and trim ends.







GIRLS SHORTS WITH BIB

- 1. Place the bib template on an 8" X 8" square of fabric folded right sides together. Stitch and cut out adding a 1/8" seam allowance.
- 2. For shorts cut fabric 13" X 6". Fold in half right sides together and stitch the long side. Turn right side out and press. Stitch the short ends together and press open. Place the center back seam against the center front. Match the center front of the bib against the center front and stitch to the waist.
- Gather waist to fit or use tucks or small elastic.
- 3. Tack between the hem between legs.
