


## Q.P. Doll – 9”

We have two pictures – one with a simple face (included on pattern) and one with an artistic face. If you wish to make an artistic face, follow the directions on the Haiti dolls. The eyes were sealed with Crystal Lacquer. If you add pompoms or buttons, sew them on securely with upholstery thread or dental floss.

Trace the face pattern and features onto paper side of stitch witchery or other fusible web. Iron to wrong side of face fabric and cut out face. Hold face up to light source (e.g. window) and lightly trace face onto fabric with pencil. Peel off paper, leaving fusible glue web on wrong side of face. Draw body pattern onto freezer paper, indicating face placement on pattern and cut out. Lay freezer paper pattern on wrong side of body fabric, indicate position of face with straight pins, and position face on right side of fabric. Fuse in place, and stitch around face with narrow satin stitch. Now reposition freezer paper pattern on wrong side of doubled fabric, placing the face over the stitched face. Iron in place, and sew around body. Paint the doll’s face after stuffing is completed, because sometimes stuffing a doll can twist or warp the face and you might want to reposition the eyes or mouth before painting. Remember, you can always erase the pencil marks.

1. Fold fabric right sides together, trace around the pattern template.
2. Cut out the doll adding a  $\frac{1}{8}$ " seam.
3. Trace the face on paper side of fusible web (Do not cut out).
4. Iron fusible web on to the flesh color fabric and cut out.
5. Position face on right side of body fabric and iron in place.
6. Machine satin stitch all the way around the face (length satin stitch - width 2.)
7. Draw or embroider face on doll.
8. Stay stitch openings on both body pieces.
9. Pin the body right sides together and machine stitch with small stitches (15-20 to the inch).
10. Turn the body right side out and stuff with fiberfill.
11. Ladder stitch the opening closed.
12. Ladder stitch the opening closed.

Materials:  
1/3 yd. print fabric  
Thread to match fabric  
4" square of flesh color fabric  
4" square of fusible web  
fiberfill  
Sakura Micron pigma 01 permanent pens, black red and brown.  
Red crayon  
Optional embroidery floss
