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Tweaking Sitting Maude to make Curling Maude

This is not the official U.S.A. uniform.

Please don't copy my Curling Maude in the same colors and patterns. Use your imagination and make her <u>your</u> Curling Maude.

Use new pattern to make straight left leg. Stuff ankle of left leg softly so foot will turn out. Use Sitting Maude instructions until you get to attaching legs. Put pants body on before attaching legs then put pants legs on and sew to body with ladder stitch.

Attach legs so body and legs are flat on bottom.

Tip knee of right leg up a bit so she is nearer the floor. She'll need a stand to hold her bottom off the floor. A small rolled piece of stiff paper made to match the floor she'll be sitting on so it won't be too noticeable.

For shirt I used ski jacket pattern with separate collar (in this pattern) I used Ultra Suede but you can use felt or make two sides out of the shirt material. I just tacked collar on. Use instructions for shoe top but don't cut out opening just slit enough for ankle.(see ski boot before the tongue and cuff are added) Embellish to suit yourself or your favorite sports company.

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Curling Stone

I used silver lame and red lame because I had it around. You can use anything you like. Shiny is nice but not necessary.

These measuremets include 1/4" seam allowance.

Bottom: 2 3/4" circle

Side: 1 1/2" x 9"

Top: 3" circle of fabric and 2 1/2" cardboard

Small Top: 2 1/2" circle of fabric (different color) and 2" cardboard

Handle: 6" chenille stem folded (color should match small top)

Glue fabric to Tops (on larger circle, don't glue to edge of cardboard. Gather seam allowance to finish edge because you have to sew the Bottom to this edge) Glue Tops together. Punch hole at one edge, insert handle, bend up excess and tape to cardboard. Glue handle on both sides at hole.

Sew Side to Bottom. Put small bag of pellets or a few pennies in bottom and stuff around and over to hold them in place. Sew Bottom to Top with ladder stitch.
